



Compostable Packaging Policy

KPS Composting Ltd provides composting and green waste recycling services from rural premises in East Sussex. We have implemented company policies to support minimising the impact of our operations on the wider climate change issue.

KPS Composting Ltd operates an open windrow composting process, a 10-14 week composting process where green waste such as grass cuttings and tree clippings are degraded into a nutrient rich material that can be used as a growing medium or soil nutrient for plant growth.

As part of the end process of producing a compost as a saleable product we use industrial hoovers that remove any plastic that may be left in.

Compostable packaging takes longer to decompose than green waste and would therefore also be removed by the hoovers at the end of the process, resulting in the compostable packaging being sent to landfill.

KPS fully support new environmental practises and continue to assess the viability of new processes but for now our site acceptance remains as green waste only.
